This week the children have been Helping to make the new gates that will go in Forest school and will be attached to the wall. Maria has been talking to the children and safety with tools and being slow when doing dangerous jobs. This is all part of helping the children understand how things are made and beginning to listen to rules and boundaries, especially in Forest school when using never before used equipment. This has supported the children's Personal, Social and Emotional development through Managing feelings and behaviour in understanding about rules and boundaries and waiting our turn to participate in some activities.

The children have also been continuing their awareness of how our body works and have made some pumping hearts. They used Dry pasta, Straws and paint to re-create how a heart pumps blood through our bodies. The children have gained a further awareness of how we need to look after our bodies to stay healthy and what we need to eat and drink to help us grow into bigger children. This has supported the children's Understand the World and learning about how things are made.

In the main classroom some of the boys were trying to do races with their cars, so we made a large race track with a very big piece of paper and some pens so the children could use this as their race track.
