This week the children have been using different resources in the garden to measure the rain fall and talking about how important rain is to us and how it helps things in the garden to grow. This has supported the children's Understanding The World Development in The World and learning about how things grow and how to look after living things.

The children have also been talking about flower names and drawing pictures of the different flowers we might see now Spring is here and the flowers are starting to grow. They have also been planting their own sunflower seeds that they are going to watch grow and then send home once too big for the classroom.

The children also explored the texture of shaving foam and talked about the different marks they could make and the feeling of the foam in their water tray. This has helped to develop the children's Expressive Arts and Design in talking about different textures for a range of resources.
