This week the children have been completing lots of weather activities, they have made a cloud and the sky using different resources, mainly cotton wool and cling film with cotton buds to paint. This has helped the children understand where rain comes from and why clouds are important, enhancing the children's Understanding the World and increasing their knowledge of The World.

The children have also been searching for NEW bugs in the garden and exploring which bugs are born now it is Spring and talking about all the new animals we might see during Spring and Summer seasons, the children have also been taking care of their Sunflower seeds they planted last week and we now appear to have some seedlings sprouting so growing very well. This has also encouraged the children's Understanding the World and learning to look after growing and living things.

In the creative Room this week the children have been making some very special gifts and cards for a special lady in their lives. (All will be revealed next week) The children have really enjoyed creating their gifts and have been talking about special people in our lives, which led the children on to continue understanding about their emotions from our emotions bucket and how we feel happy and sad and this can change throughout the day. This has supported the children's Personal, Social and Emotional development through Managing Feelings and Behaviour. 😊

The children have also been exploring Numbers and how many of each item they can find, they completed a Number Hunt around the classroom and were introduced to adding and taking away to make specific numbers. The children talked about how splitting something makes it more and how many things we could fit in to a space. This has helped to develop the children's Mathematics development through learning about Numbers.
