This really supported the children's problem-solving skills and helped to further develop their writing skills through mark making for different purposes.

The children also helped Teresa mix the pancake mixture and then watched her from the kitchen door how to make and flip pancakes. The children really enjoyed watching this and then they ate them for their dessert after lunch. This has helped increase the children's mathematical skills by weighing and measuring and their Understand the World through learning about different cultures and traditions.
