This week in Forest school the children have been talking about the plants and flowers and what happens to them when they do not receive enough water and too much warmth and sunlight. The children have been learning about Growth, decay and how to revive the plants. This has supported the children's Understand the World development through learning how things grow and looking after and caring for living things.

The children also made London town and witness a fire in Forest School to talk further about London's Burning and what happened in the Great Fire of London. They then sang London's Burning song. This has helped the children learn about people and community through understanding what happened in history previously.

In the creative room the children helped to make and paint a 'Lost and Found' Box. We talked to the children and keeping our own possessions where we know they are so we can take them home at the end of the day. The lost and found box will be displayed in the cloakroom and any items of clothes or toys that are not claimed will be put in here at the end of the day. Please make sure you have a look through in case any of your children's items are in there.

The children have also been car painting this week and understanding about the marks the different tyres on different cars can make in the paint. The children then talked about mixing paint and the colours this would make when mixed together. This has supported the children's expressive Arts and design development through understanding about colours and what happens when they are mixed together.
