At Forest School we have been participating in the Spring watch challenge we completed mission 1 'Mammals' and mission 2 'Worms and Bugs' This has helped to increase the children's awareness of the world around us and to have an understanding of the mini beats we could find in the natural garden. This has increased the children's Understanding The World.

The children have also been listening to songs to choose for the leavers party in July and have been enjoying all the singing and practising. This has helped developed the children's Expressive Arts and Design in listening to music and how sound is made.

The children have also been practising taking their shoes and socks off and putting them back on.
