At Forest School the children have been caring for their seedlings, which are now growing very fast and have stems and leaves on. They are very excited to start to see onions, runner beans, courgettes, tomatoes and strawberries growing there. This has helped support the children's Understanding The World through looking after living things. The children will continue to monitor the growth of the fruit and vegetables as the weeks progress.

The children have also been mixing colours in the creative room and making shapes in paint using the Montessori inset shapes, whilst also mark making using the paint. This has helped develop the children's Expressive Arts and Design through understanding how to make different colours through mixing.

Also in the Creative room the children have been exploring the different marks they can make in shaving foam in the tough spot. They used cars, blocks, duplo and stickle bricks to make different marks and shapes in the foam. This has helped support the children's literacy development through understanding how different marks are made.

Some of the children have also been showing off their letter forming skills and writing their names in my (Laura's) birthday card. I was so overwhelmed by all their efforts and their little names. I will certainly cherish this birthday card for a long while. 😊
