Baby room would like to welcome Sophie and Mila to the room. This week baby room have been exploring lids, using hand eye co-ordination to put lids on and also take them off again, looking at sizes and shapes. Mathematics and physical development. Also they

have been working on circle times, playing musical instruments and exploring sounds and building a connection to each other in circle time.

Next week baby Room will be experimenting with BUBBLES & PAINT to explore colours and textures in creating master pieces.



Pre-School have been looking at the new season 'AUTUMN' and finding acorns along with leaves of many colours, we have looked at the veins in a leaf and looked closely at the different colours in a leaf. Then we have made our own stain glass leaves for our book area. This has developed our understanding of seasons throughout the year and built an understanding of patterns in our environment.
